## **Mental Health Services**

Facilitated by a team of skilled mental health counsellors, psychotherapists, and social workers, Rebound's mental health services connect children and youth with responsive and relevant support, counselling, and therapy. Our team of highly-trained professionals are equipped to meet clients where they are at, with supports that address their mental health and emotional wellness needs.

## **Individual Counselling & Therapy**

For children and youth 7-18. Each client benefits from a quick access brief services format with 4-6 counselling or therapy sessions. This solution focused approach addresses the immediate needs and goals of the client. A collaborative assessment and discussion of needs may determine further support is required. Our services engage the family, and can be integrated with community supports. Service is available in-person and through our secure virtual platforms.

## **Group Services**

Emotion Regulation Groups are 8-week programs that are clinically designed and researched for young people who are struggling to cope with their emotions.

- Attention & Impulsivity Group: For young people struggling with behaviour issues, big emotions, anger, attention, or impulsive choices
- Mood: For young people struggling with low moods, irritability, or symptoms of depression and sadness.
- Anxiety: For young people struggling with anxiety and anxious thoughts
