## APPLICATION FOR EXTRAJUDICIAL MEASURES (EJM) PROGRAM

I, \_\_\_\_\_, wish to be considered for the **EJM Program** including intake, assessment, and service options through Rebound Child & Youth Services Inc. ("Rebound"). This Police referral option (YJCA s.6) has been explained to me and I have been advised of my right to counsel. I am seeking service options in Northumberland County, and I voluntarily agree to participate in the Extrajudicial Measures Program. I promise to contact Rebound's Youth Justice Intake at 905 372 0007 x.222, within 48 hours to arrange an interview. *\*If the call goes to voicemail, leaving a message will count as initiating contact*

I understand that following intake, Rebound will report to the Police Service to confirm that I have made the necessary contacted and have been accepted to the program. I further understand that if I do not follow through with my responsibilities, the Police Service may choose to deal with this offence through the judicial system. The outcome of my participation will also be reported to the referring Police Service.

## Extrajudicial Measures (EJM) Program

The Extrajudicial Measures Program is designed to provide young people with the opportunity to be held accountable for their actions, without having formal criminal charges laid against them.

Rebound Child & Youth Services is the agency that facilitates the EJM Program for ALL police services in Northumberland County.

### GUIDELINES

Once you have received this sheet, you have 48 hours (2 days) to contact Rebound YJ department on 905 372 0007 x.222. You are responsible for arranging an intake appointment. A case worker will be assigned to you and will work to determine if you fit the criteria required to participate in the EJM Program.

Following your intake and once you have been accepted into the program, a contract will be created for you. This contract will outline the Measures (assignments/required program participation) that you must complete. This contract may be created between you and your case worker, or you may be required to attend a Youth Justice Committee meeting to discuss your individual situation.

Youth Justice Committee Meetings are scheduled regularly and is facilitated by 3 trained community volunteers and may be attended by the victim(s) and/or police.

Measures can be, but are not limited to, letters of apology to the person harmed, community service work, an essay, or specific program attendance.

Upon successful completion of all set measures, the young person's file will be closed, and no further action will be taken.

Any young person that does not complete their required measures will have their file close as UNSUCCESSFUL, and their charges will be addressed by the referring Police Service.

Police Services or parents may indicate a preference or recommendation for one or more of the following programs as part of the referral process:

- Life skills
- Drug & Substance Abuse program
- Anger Awareness
- Employment Readiness program
- Healthy Relationships
- Equity & Diversity Awareness
- Tutoring
